

Poster: Information for Authors

Successful submission of your poster does not guarantee inclusion in the conference programme. After the submission deadline, we will inform you whether your poster has been accepted.

The first author of the poster must register for the conference after the programme has been published and must present the poster in person at the DOG conference. Delegation is only possible in cases of illness or other serious circumstances and requires approval from the Secretary General.

If you wish to make changes to your poster submission, please resubmit the form with the updated information and include a brief note under "Any accessibility or special requirements?". Alternatively, you may contact the conference office (www.tagung@do-g.de) by email with your requested changes.

Information on the location of the poster exhibition will be provided after poster registration and in the programme booklet. A maximum usable area of 100 cm in width and 125 cm in height (portrait format) is available for each poster. **Posters may be mounted from Thursday, 17th September, 08:30. Posters must be removed again by Saturday, 19th September, 12:00.** No responsibility is taken for posters left behind. Posters will not be returned.

The following guidelines have proven effective: title in font size 100 pt (e.g., an uppercase H is then 2.5 cm high); text not smaller than 22 pt (approx. 6 mm height for an uppercase letter); name, address, and – ideally – a photo of the authors in the upper section of the poster to facilitate contact; a structure and layout that remain clearly legible from a distance of 1.5 m.
